

SOME QUOTATIONS FROM THE SCRIPTURES AND ELLEN G. WHITE PERTAINING TO

THE FINAL END OF SIN AND SINNERS

INTRODUCTION: Please note several points about the organization of this collection that hopefully will make it easier to understand and useful to the reader:

1. The titles to each section, and the associated boxes are attempts to summarize the materials that are included in that particular section.
2. In the paragraphs of explanation, all words, phrases, or sentences in bold quotes like this--“**bold quotes**”--are actual words taken from the Scriptures or Ellen White, and if you look at the associated passages identified by the superscript at the end of the quote you will be able to locate the word / phrase / sentence in its original context. The numbers identify the number of the quote in this collection. Within the quoted material words in (...) are from the original source, while words in [...] have been added by us for clarification or further reference. Words in {...} were supplied in the original. Underlined passages are particularly noteworthy.
3. A few passages appear in the writings of Ellen White in several books which were published at different times in her history. Over the years publishing practices changed, just as they are doing even now. On some occasions Ellen White felt it was appropriate to edit something that she had published previously and re-publish it in a new format or a new collection of her materials. It is interesting to note some small changes in style and grammar over the years. In an attempt to speak more clearly and to be better understood, she would sometimes significantly rephrase some sentences. Where we have found two such passages that are worded slightly differently, we have included the different passages using the same number with a letter after the number to indicate the order in which they were written. For example, 150.a, 150.b, 150.c, and 150.d are four different wordings of an important passage as she edited it over the years from 1858 to 1888. It is useful to note how her thoughts developed over the years.

This collection of quotations has been brought together with the help of many people. While it is not possible to include every passage that might be relevant in any way, we have tried our best to include the most important passages and more than that, we have tried to represent as fairly as we can all the different ideas that we have come across relative to the topic of “*The Final End of Sin and Sinners*”. There are no doubt some passages that we have missed, and if you feel that you have discovered some important passage that is relevant to this topic but is not adequately represented in this collection *please* feel free to write us and share the passage with us and it will be included in future updates (this is now revision #3). In light of this, you will note that at the very end of this collection there is a date which represents the date when it was printed. May God bless you in studying this challenging subject.
